Victims of sexual offences are entitled to **psychosocial and legal assistance** – if it is required by how much they were personally affected.

Legal representation ensures that victims' rights are protected and that claims are enforced in criminal proceedings.

The **psychosocial legal support** provides information on the course of proceedings, preparation for interrogations and protected support for reporting crimes and court proceedings.

Ideally, **legal assistance** begins before the incident is reported and ends after the court proceedings have been concluded.
